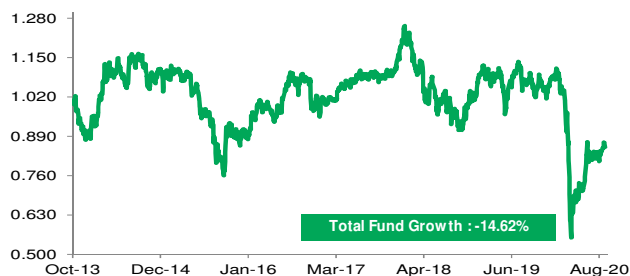

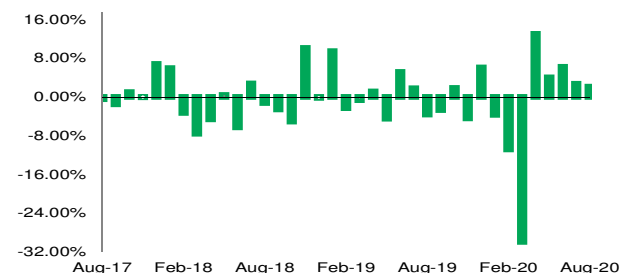

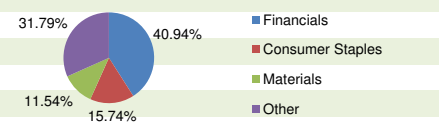

Investment Manager Commentary

Indonesia equity continued its positive trend in August driven by optimism of economic recovery. Global and domestic economic data showed overall improvement, notably from manufacturing, retail, and employment sectors. Market optimism also supported by US central bank's statement that indicates it is likely to maintain accommodative policy longer than previous expectation. On the domestic market, acceleration of government stimulus disbursement is a focus for the market. The government has disbursed 13th salary for civil servant and prepares benefit scheme for private sector employee to support purchasing power. Rupiah was volatile in August, but it managed to closed higher 0.3% in the month to 14,563 per USD. Portfolio allocation in real estate and materials posted positive attribution, while allocation in consumer staples and health care posted negative attribution.

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
