


Performance Since Inception

Investment Manager Commentary

Equity market was under pressure in January due to uncertainty regarding the impact of coronavirus outbreak to the economy. The uncertainty caused risk-off sentiment in the market and sell-off in global equity market, including Indonesia where JCl fell 5.71% in January. Foreign investors posted net buy of IDR15 billion in the equity market, and Rupiah appreciated 1.52% against USD to 13,655. Global economic data showed signs of improvement in January, with manufacturing data showed expansion, following the improvement from the end of 2019. On the domestic front, macroeconomy data remain stable with inflation manageable at 2.68% YoY in January and foreign reserves increased USD2.5 billion to USD131.7 billion. Portfolio allocation in Communication Services and Financials sectors posted positive attribution, while allocation in Utilities and Materials posted negative attribution.
