

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Investment Manager Commentary

Equity market continued its positive performance in June where global sentiment improves as economic data shows recovery following lockdown easing. Employment data, retail sales, and manufacturing shows improvement in several countries that began to reopen its economy in May-June period. This supports optimism that the economy will start to recover in second half of 2020. Indonesia also enters to PSBB transition periode in June with Jakarta partially lifting some restrictions. This fuels market optimism of the beginning of market recovery. Bank Indonesia continues its accommodative policy by cutting interest rate from 4.50% to 4.25% in June. Rupiah appreciates 2.36% against USD to 14,265. Portfolio allocation in consumer staples and communications sectors posted positive attribution, while allocation in industrials and real estate posted negative attribution.

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
