


#### Performance Since Inception

# **Investment Manager Commentary**

Equity market suffered deep correction in March where market sentiment turned negative following Covid-19 outbreak that spread globally. Higher outbreak intensity and various mitigation measures with social distancing or lockdown are likely to have negative impact on economic growth. JCl suffered correction 16.76% in March and Rupiah depreciate 13.9% to 16,310 per USD. To ease the burden on the economy, various governments and central banks introduced big stimulus measures. US government announced USD2 trillion fiscal stimulus, and the Indonesian government also announced IDR405 trillion stimulus, its biggest ever stimulus, in a bid to support the economy. Bank Indonesia also continues its intervention in bond and forex market to stabilize the market. So far these policies managed to calm the market and reduce market volatility. Portfolio allocation in Materials and Communication sectors posted positive attribution, while allocation in Real Estate and Industrials posted negative attribution.

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
