
Performance Since Inception

Investment Manager Commentary

Asia Pacific equity market was volatile in October amid rising Covid-19 case and uncertainty ahead of US election in early November. Europe and US reported rising Covid-19 cases in October that pushed some countries to tighten social restriction, which may affect recovery process. The market was also concerned by lengthy negotiation for additional US fiscal stimulus. The Fed commented repeatedly that additional stimulus is needed to support further US recovery. On the positive note, China economy grew 4.9% YoY in Q3-2020, up from 3.2% in Q2-2020. This indicates recovery momentum remains strong in China. Overall, FTSE Sharia Asia Pacific ex Japan index rose 0.21% in October. Portfolio allocation in IT and Communication posted positive attribution, while allocation in Materials and Health care posted negative attribution.
