

Investment Manager Commentary

Indonesia equity market rebounded in October following the approval of Job Creation Omnibus Law bill in the Parliament. The market sees the bill as potential catalyst that could improve Indonesia's industrial competitiveness and support economic growth. Indonesia GDP fell -3.49% YoY in 3Q-2020, improved from -5.32% in Q2-2020. The market responded positive on this data that indicate the economy is in recovery mode. Meanwhile, global markets sentiments were mixed in October due to uncertainty of US election and rising Covid-19 cases in Europe and US. Local investors were the driver for Indonesia equity in October as foreign investors posted net outflow IDR3.7 trillion. Rupiah appreciated 1.71% in October to 14,625 per USD. Portfolio allocation in real estate and materials posted negative attribution.
