


## **Performance Since Inception**

# **Investment Manager Commentary**

Equity market was volatile in December affected by hawkish statement from The Fed and selling pressure from foreign investor in the domestic market. The Fed raised benchmark rate by 50bps to 4.50 inline with market expectation, a smaller hike compared to 75bps increment the previous months. However, statement from Fed Chair Jerome Powell emphasized that monetary tightenting will not be eased in the short term and interest rate may be higher than previous expectation due to persistent inflation and strong labor sector. On the domestic front, the market was under pressure from foreign outflow that posted net sell IDR21 trillion in the equity market. China economic reopening caused rebalancing from market that outperformed such as Indonesia to underperformed markets as North Asia. However, there was no changes in Indonesia fundamentals that remain supportive, where trade balance continue to post surplus USD5.2 billion, forex reserve increased to USD137.2 billion, and inflation fell to 5.51% YoY from its peak of 5.95% in September. Portfolio allocation in energy and communication contributed positive attribution, meanwhile allocation in healthcare and financial contributed negative attribution to performance.
