
Performance Since Inception

Investment Manager Commentary

Indonesia equity market strengthened outperforming the regional and emerging market equities, meanwhile Rupiah weakened 2.44% against USD. High global inflation, tightening monetary policy, as well as prolonged geopolitical conflicts and the pandemic are the main risks for the market. During the month foreign investors booked a net buy of USD730 million. Bank Indonesia is expected to continue increasing rates to support the attractiveness of Rupiah and Indonesia financial assets. Higher inflation this year will still be manageable and much lower compared to the >8% inflation rate during the 2013 monetary tightening cycle. The economy reopening and high corporate earnings growth will provide supports for the equity market. Portfolio allocation in financials and health care contributed positive attribution, meanwhile allocation in consumer staples and communication services contributed negative attribution to performance.
