



Monthly Performance Last 3 Years





Investment Manager Commentary

Indonesia USD bond market posted negative performance in July as volatile global market sentiment caused US Treasury yield to rise 20bps to 3.96%. The Fed raised benchmark rate by 25bps in July, inline with market expectation, but maintain the possibility of further rate hike in September. Meanwhile US inflation and economic growth data were better than expected that raised the view recession in the US can be avoided. Despite of global volatility, Indonesia macroeconomic condition remain strong, Inflation continue to moderate to 3.08% Voy from 3.52% Voy from 4.52% Voy the previous month, and trade balance posted wider surplus to USD3.5 billion, from USD0.4 billion the previous month. Bank Indonesia maintained benchmark rate at 5.75% as expected and reiterated its priority is safeguard Rupiah stability.
