

#### **Performance Since Inception**







# **Investment Manager Commentary**

Asia ex Japan REITs markets rose in July, continuing their positive momentum alongside broader Asia equities. Market sentiment was driven by easing of tariffs and trade tensions as several key economies reached trade deal with the US. The US Federal Reserve kept policy rates unchanged in July and was non-committal over its next policy meeting decision in September 2025. The market continued to price in another two rate cuts by the end of 2025. Lower financing costs and improving macro indicators across the region underpinned REIT performance. US President Trump's chaotic tariffs policies remain in focus. Investors are also watching out for any escalation in geopolitical conflicts which could hurt the current risk-on sentiment. We believe healthier real estate fundamentals and balance sheet, coupled with lower financing rates and potential rate cuts are likely to cushion downside for Asia REITs.
