

Investment Manager Commentary

Indonesia reached trade deal with the US, with tariff at 19%. Indonesia is committed to purchase more US goods and investment in the US. The deal is seen as positive by the market because of competitive tariff rate against peers, while higher imports from the US is not seen as hurdle due to the nature of US products are not competing with domestic industries. Bank Indonesia cut benchmark rate by 25bps to 5.25% in July, the third rate cut this year, amid low domestic inflation and the need to support growth. BI signals room for further rate cut, escpecially as uncertainty regarding US tariff has diminished. Amid weak domestic growth, the government expects fiscal deficit to widen in 2025 from 2.5% to 2.75% due to weak tax revenue and spending need for government's priority programs. The government will utilize excess cash balance (SAL) of IDR85.6 trillion to cover the shortfall and ease the burden on SBN issuance. S&P ratings maintained Indonesia sovereign rating at 'BBB' (stable), that reflect global investors' confidence on Indonesia's fiscal position.

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
