

INVESTMENT Wanager Commentary

October was a positive month for the financial markets. Easing liquidity environment and additions stitulus from the government drove market sentiment in the month. Domestic liquidity showed improvement following shifting in government's cash placement from Bank Indonesia to SOE banks. Primary money (M0) grew 18% YOY in September and M2 grew 8% YOY, up from 7.6% the previous month. Bank loan growth also improved to 7.2% YOY in September from 7.0% the previous month. The government maintains its pro-growth stance, announced new stimulus of cash handouts worth IDR 30 trillion for October - December period, for 35 million households. This is the fourth stimulus package from the government is year in effort to boost growth, and expected to have more direct impact to consumption compared to previous stimulus because of the cash nature. Portfolio allocations in energy contributed positive attributions, meanwhile allocations in real estate contributed negative attributions to performance.

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
