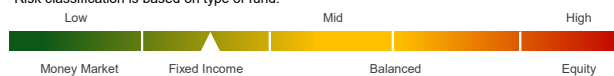

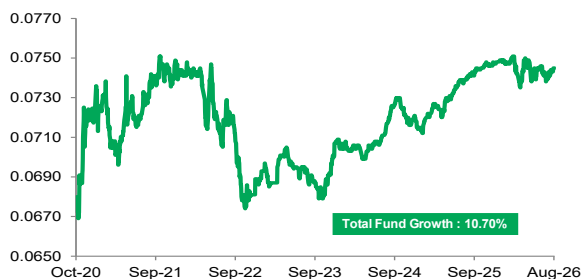

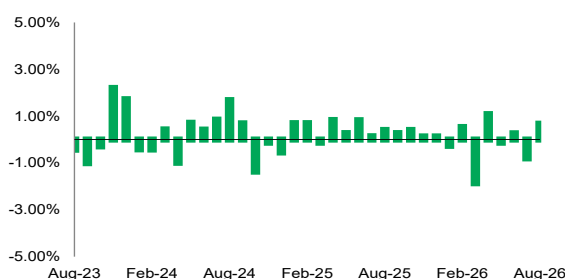

Monthly Performance Last 3 Years

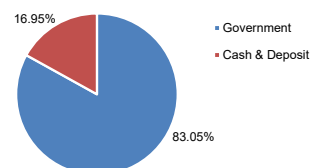

Investment Manager Commentary

Indonesia's bond market delivered a positive performance in August, supported by improving risk perception towards Indonesia markets. Indonesia's economy expanded by 5.29% YoY in 2026, surpassing market expectations. Growth was driven by resilient household consumption, stronger investment activity, and continued expansionary government spending. Bank Indonesia maintained its policy rate at 5.75%, in line with market expectations. BI emphasized that preserving Rupiah stability remains its key policy priority. In addition to keeping interest rates unchanged, BI indicated a reduced reliance on SRBI as a tool to support the Rupiah, while increasing the use of incentives for hedging instruments as part of its policy framework to safeguard currency stability. Market sentiment was also supported by the 2027 State Budget (RAPBN 2027) framework, which reinforced the government's commitment to maintaining a fiscal deficit below 3% of GDP. The government targets a fiscal deficit of 2.4% of GDP in 2027, lower than the 2026 deficit outlook of 2.85%, underscoring its continued focus on fiscal discipline. Bond yield fell across tenors in steepening pattern, where the 5-year yield fell -44bps, and the 10-year yield fell -33bps.

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
