Manulife Indonesia Inaugurates Clean Water and Sanitation Facility for Thousands of Villagers in Pasir Angin Village, Bogor

Jakarta – PT Asuransi Jiwa Manulife Indonesia (“Manulife Indonesia) continues to strengthen its commitment to support communities through social impact initiatives. As part of this commitment, Manulife Indonesia has launched clean water and sanitation facilities at Pasir Angin Village, Cigudeg, Bogor, and launched a series of educational activities focused on community health and financial literacy. The activities – benefiting more than 2,000 people, including villagers, teachers, and students from four primary and secondary schools – were part of Manulife Indonesia’s 40th anniversary celebrations, marking four decades of the Manulife Indonesia contribution in helping Indonesians achieve better lives.

As part of Manulife’s Impact Agenda and its commitment to empowering sustained health and well-being, since 2022 in various areas such as Bekasi and Banten this program aims to address the unmet basic needs of the community, focusing on meeting essential community needs, particularly those related to access to clean water and proper sanitation. This program also supports the government’s efforts to achieve the target of 100% access to clean water nationwide.¹ However, based on data from Indonesia’s Central Statistics Agency (BPS), as of 2024, only 92.64% of the population currently has access to safe drinking water², and only 83.69% have access to proper sanitation.³

“Creating a positive impact in the community is an important part of Manulife’s values. This initiative reflects our global Share Your Humanity value and aligns with our broader global Impact Agenda. This is a tangible manifestation of our commitment to creating a real difference in the communities where we live and work. Through this initiative, we want to ensure that people, especially the younger generation, have a healthier and stronger foundation to build their futures,” said **Apriliani Siregar, Director and General Counsel Manulife Indonesia**, in her remarks during the inauguration ceremony at Pasir Angin Village, Cigudeg, Bogor.

The program goes beyond building clean water sources and sanitation facilities by also offering a range of community development activities. These include free health checks—such as blood pressure, uric acid, and blood sugar screenings—and educational sessions on personal hygiene and disease prevention for residents.

This activity also engaged the younger generation through financial education classes held in the four schools, reaching over a thousand students and teachers. These sessions were supported by Manulife's Pension Funds (DPLK) team, Manulife Aset Management Indonesia (MAMI) and the Manulife Syariah Indonesia team. Manulife Indonesia also organised a village cleanup activity in collaboration with residents and volunteers, focusing on cleaning public areas, including roads, fields, and waterways. More than 80 volunteers, including Manulife Indonesia employees and distribution partners, took part in this one day initiative.

The program was organized in collaboration with various partners, including Yayasan Manulife Peduli, Dompot Dhuafa Social Enterprise, Halodoc and Hermina Bogor Hospital, government agencies, and local communities. The success of this implementation marks a further step for Manulife Indonesia in its ongoing efforts to take real action and achieve a more prosperous life for all.
